Partnership with NSRA

The Nebraska State Recycling Association (NSRA) received a grant from the Nebraska Department of Environmental Quality to perform Computer Collection Events statewide. Three collections, scheduled for this fall, are planned and will be run on the model of the WasteCap Collection Event held this April at State Fair Park in Lincoln. WasteCap will provide site-specific Keep Nebraska Beautiful affiliates with the technical information necessary to organize and implement the collections. This partnership is an attempt to bring recycling information to rural areas of the state, to answer questions concerning the end life of computer equipment and to establish a process by which individual communities can meet their computer disposal needs.
