**Banned Items Could Cost Businesses \$\$**  
WasteCap of Lincoln wanted to remind their members that certain items, such as fluorescent tubes and computer equipment, are banned from the landfill. We took the liberty of looking up the penalties for violations of these restricted items. The following list was compiled from the City of Lincoln Municipal Code Section 8.32.360.

- 1st offense: \$100
- 2nd offense: \$250
- 3rd offense: \$500

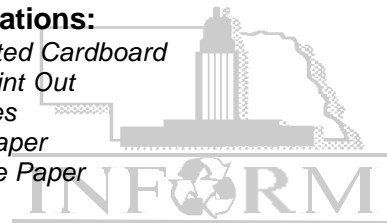
